

PARK BLEND

APPLICATION

Park Blend is a mix of Kentucky Bluegrass, Tall Fescue and Perennial Ryegrass. Park Blend is great for parks, home lawns, and commercial landscapes. It has good drought resistance and wear tolerance.



COLOR & TEXTURE

It is characterized as having a dark green color with medium and fine textured leaves. With high density and a bare-foot soft feel.

SOIL TYPE

Grows well in all types, from heavy clay to sandy soils. Displays an above average tolerance to acidic, alkaline, saline and poorly drained soils.

MOWING

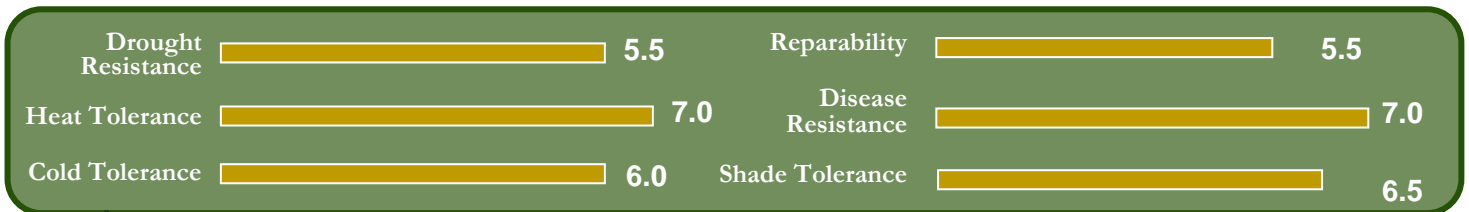
Mow to a height of 1.5 to 2.5 inches. Frequency is once a week. Rotary or reel mower.

WATERING

To avoid dry out, all newly planted turf should be watered daily and soaked thoroughly to a depth of 3 inches for the first 10 to 14 days. After that initial period, water deeply and infrequently whenever grass is showing signs of dehydration. This will be a very good low water use grass.

FERTILIZATION

0.5 to 1 pound of actual nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing month when combined with recommended phosphorous and potassium. A good rule of thumb is to apply **slow release fertilizers** around the holidays (Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor day and Halloween) Good slow release fertilizer can be applied around each of these holidays. If you want to cut water requirements substitute Iron or micronutrients for the July application. Good balanced fertilizer 21-14-5-3F or 20-10-10-3F. Halloween application should be a good quality winterizer.
